## In this Issue:

CED 400 units are to only be transported, or moved, with legs not attached. Do not attempt to slide unit while legs are installed, this may damage the bottom plate. Additionally, attempting to slide the unit can present a tipping hazard. Legs are only to be installed when the unit is at a permanent location. Unit should only be lifted from bottom metal structure.

## Optional Method of Leg Installation for Ease of Access:

1. Remove refrigeration and carbonation decks from unit.
2. Place unit on side.
3. Proceed to install legs as shown below, turning clockwise until securely in place.
